Uses:

Tack Band SR can be used on the following surfaces:

- Concrete and water-based coating
- Most metal surfaces
- Most painting surfaces
- Glass, Perspex, polycarbonate

Surfaces must be clean, dry and free of dust.

When replacing bituminous tape, free the surface of any bituminous traces and remove grease with a solvent.

Start peeling the release paper and position the product. Continue stripping the liner off gradually.

Simultaneously press firmly to avoid air bubbles.

Press the product down firmly once applied.

Recommended pression between 5 g/cm², Tack Band SR can be painted after a preliminary test.
